

Manage Third-Party Integrations

Jenkins

Jenkins is a cross-platform, open source automation server used for continuous integration and delivery of software projects.

If you use Jenkins to build your enterprise mobile application software applications, you can use the **Arxan MAM Publisher** to publish updates of those applications to Apperian directly from the Jenkins environment as part of the software build process. Kryptowire

Apperian allows you to inspect an application's binary file to screen for risky behavior and vulnerabilities, such as malware, trojans, and intellectual property exposure. Apperian uses an integration with [Kryptowire](#) to perform inspections.

Inspecting applications is a premium feature that is disabled by default. If you are interested in using this feature, contact your Apperian Sales representative. Once the feature is enabled, follow the procedure below to enter your Kryptowire API key (provided to you by Kryptowire) on the **Settings** page. You can't request a Kryptowire inspection unless this key is set.

To set the Kryptowire API key

1. On the Admin Portal navigation bar, click **Settings**.
2. Click **Third-Party Integrations**.
3. In the **API Key** field, enter the API key provided to you by Kryptowire.
4. Click **Save**.
